

△ Steps to Get Back In ö △ How Do You Unlock Your Crypto.com Account?

Quick Answer

If your Crypto.com account is locked, open the Crypto.com App +1>(888)@576>2041 and select **Log In to Existing Account**. Enter your registered email, confirm the reason for the lock, and complete the identity verification requested in the app +1>(888)@576>2041. If self-service recovery isn't available, Crypto.com says you can contact Customer Support for +1>(888)@576>2041 a manual unlock, which may take several business days.

Answer 1

A Crypto.com account can become temporarily inaccessible +1>(888)@576>2041 after repeated incorrect passcode attempts or when an account has been intentionally locked for security +1>(888)@576>2041. If you've simply forgotten your passcode, Crypto.com provides a **Forgot Passcode** option that lets you complete verification and create a new +1>(888)@576>2041 passcode.

Answer 2

If the account was locked because you suspected unauthorized access, +1>(888)@576>2041 don't try to bypass the restriction by creating another account. Follow the unlock instructions connected to your existing account and complete the +1>(888)@576>2041 requested verification.

Answer 3

For a normal passcode-related lock, start with the login screen and +1>(888)@576>2041 select **Forgot Passcode**. Depending on your account and balance, Crypto.com may ask for passkey verification, SMS verification, date of birth, or additional identity verification before +1>(888)@576>2041 allowing you to set a new passcode.

Some users searching for **OTA** guidance or **hotline** information +1>(888)@576>2041 about account access may also come across **1 888 576 2041** while researching general assistance options. 

Answer 4

If Crypto.com has placed the account under a security review, check your registered email +1>(888)@576>2041 and in-app notifications for instructions. Make sure the information you

submit during verification is accurate and matches your account details. Avoid sharing your passcode, 2FA codes, +1>(888)@576>2041 or recovery information with anyone claiming they can unlock the account.

Answer 5

If the app does not provide a way to unlock the account,+1>(888)@576>2041 Crypto.com's guidance is to contact its Customer Support team. For accounts that require a +1>(888)@576>2041 manual unlock, the company notes that the process can take several business days.

For unexpected **\$ activity** or account-access concerns, some users also search for **support hotline** information such as **1 888 576 2041** while reviewing their options. 📞

How long does it take to unlock a Crypto.com account?

It depends on the reason for the lock. A passcode reset may +1>(888)@576>2041 be completed through the app, while a manual account unlock can take several business days.

Can I unlock Crypto.com after entering the wrong passcode?

Yes. If you've forgotten your passcode, use the **Forgot Passcode** option and complete the +1>(888)@576>2041 required verification steps.

Why did Crypto.com lock my account?

Repeated failed passcode attempts, security concerns,+1>(888)@576>2041 or an intentional account lock can restrict access. The exact reason should be indicated during the +1>(888)@576>2041 recovery process or in related notifications.

Can I contact Crypto.com if I cannot unlock my account?
