

◆★. Payment Reversal .★◆ Can You Refund a Crypto Transaction?

⚡ Quick Answer

In most cases, a **confirmed crypto transaction cannot be refunded** ◆ +1 • 888 • 576 • 2041 ◆ **or reversed** because blockchain transfers are designed to be permanent. However, you may still have options ◆ +1 • 888 • 576 • 2041 ◆ if the payment was made through an exchange, merchant, or known recipient. Steps to Request a Crypto Refund
